Notes to archers and visitors for this event

GNAS - Law 14 - Archers must produce their GNAS card when booking in.

GNAS - Rule 307 Dress regulations will apply - "The recognised dress of the Society is plain dark green and/or white".

DRUG TESTING - Record status shoots are liable for drug testing. Refusal to comply with a request for a sample will be treated as a positive result. All archers claiming awards i.e. records, rose and six gold ends will be required to certify that they are not taking banned substances.

HEALTH AND SAFETY - All archers and visitors attending the event must conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or others at risk.

PARKING OF VEHICLES - Bucks Archery Association and Aylesbury Rugby Football Club, their agents or servants cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles whilst archers or visitors are attending this event.

PERSONAL PROPERTY - Bucks Archery Association and Aylesbury Rugby Football Club, their agents or servants cannot accept responsibility for loss of personal property by archers or visitors whilst attending this event.

AWARDS - County and Visitor awards for ladies and gentlemen according to entries.

Team awards, four archers from the same club shooting the recurve bow or four archers shooting the compound bow. Teams must include one lady or one gentleman.

The Long-bow team award will be based on two adult archers scores.

Married Couples awards for Recurve, Compound and Long-bow styles.

(Awards for the National Round will be limited to first year novice archers or those archers who have not reached 3rd class).
